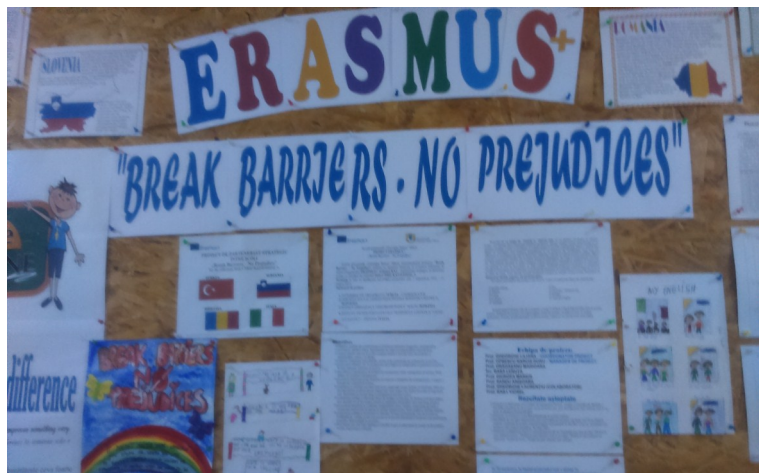

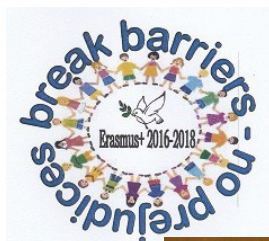

1st November—All Saints' Day is both a religious and a national holiday in Italy.

10th November— Death Day of Mustafa Kemal ATATURK (founder of the Republic of Turkey)

24th November—One of those reforms of Ataturk was the adoption of the Latin Alphabet rather than the Arabic. With the adoption of the new alphabet; a mobilization started to teach the new letters and improve the ratio of literacy among community. And on this regard on November 24th, 1928, National Schools were founded to teach literacy to people, and Ataturk accepted the role of being The Head Teacher of the nation.

1st December—Great Union Day, National Day in Romania is celebrated annually every December 1st to commemorate the expansion of Romania to, more or less, its present-day boundaries in the aftermath of World War I. National Day is also called “Great Union Day,” since it is the day on which Transylvania, Bessarabia, and Bukovina joined Romania in 1918.

8th December—Immaculate Conception in Italy celebrates the virginity of Mary

26th December—Independence and Unity Day in Slovenia the day when citizens voted to break away from the former Yugoslavia. The vote was actually held on December 23, 1990, but the results were made known three days later.
